This course can provide a pathway towards Certificate III in Individual Support, nursing or other health qualifications.


Taking Expressions of Interest for 2026

# Room & Hall Hire


#### Offices and Classrooms


#### **Licensed Kitchen**

#### **Hall Hire**


We have a large events room/hall for hire.
